The New York City Department of Transportation (NYCDOT) Hunts Point Clean Trucks Program (HPCTP) is within reach of replacing 500 older heavy-polluting diesel trucks with 2010 EPA emission compliant diesel-hybrid, compressed natural gas, and diesel Class 3 to Class 8 trucks.

The HPCTP has replaced food distribution, beverage delivery, commercial carrier, waste and recycling, fuel service, cement, and moving and storage trucks. These 500 new trucks have resulted in significant environmental benefits by helping to improve air quality in the South Bronx since the launch of the program in 2012.
